To receive the Agriculture Leadership Scholarship, Nora displayed exceptional participation and leadership in agriculture-related activities as well as high academic achievement. In total, Epsilon distributes \$6,000 in scholarship and award dollars annually to encourage students to improve their academic performance, pursue leadership development opportunities, and to explore agricultural careers.

Alpha Gamma Rho is a social as well as professional organization for young men pursuing an undergraduate or post-graduate degree in agriculture, food, fiber, life sciences, natural resources, forestry, environmental or related agricultural fields. AGR was the first Greek organization established on the NDSU campus and is celebrating its centennial anniversary in 2013. Epsilon Chapter of Alpha Gamma Rho was installed on March 24, 1913 as the fifth chapter of the national fraternity. The chapter was given the namesake Epsilon, which is the fifth letter of the Greek alphabet. Today Epsilon is one of 70 AGR chapters across the US.
